Hello EOEE 4th Day community,

May each of you feel the love, grace and mercy of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ and may you be blessed richly as you seek to serve Him.

We are still on track for holding Fall Walks at Camp Wanake, may God be praised! As we prepare for the Walks, I want to ask for some very important support from each of you. With the onset of Covid and the need to cancel Walks, our Community (along with every other Emmaus Community) found itself on very unfamiliar ground. We have had an amazing run of holding multiple Walks every year in the East Ohio Emmanuel Emmaus Community. For many years we held 6 Walks—3 for men and 3 for women—each year. More recently, we have been holding 4 Walks each year—2 for men and 2 for women. When we hold our Fall Walks in October, it will have been 2 full years since we've had an Emmaus Walk in our Community.

There is good news and bad news inherent in a lack of Walks. On the good side, there should be some pent-up demand and theoretically, more potential pilgrims that we can ask to go on Walks. On the bad side, not holding Walks has a way of negatively impacting momentum. While we have tried to so some things to bring the Community together using Zoom Gatherings, we all know that it's just not the same as meeting face to face and spending time together at Camp Wanake.

The help that I am asking for, is assistance with building some good positive momentum.

- 1. Pray about Pilgrims that you are being called to invite to attend a Walk.

 Remember that they should be men and women who are solid in their faith walk with a home church that they attend and serve regularly.
- 2. Pray about ways you can serve leading up to and during the Fall Walks. Sign up for the Prayer Vigil, write Agape, make table Agape or bring snack Agape, attend Candlelight and Closing.
- 3. Pray for the Teams and Pilgrims.

It will take some concerted effort on all our parts to rebuild positive momentum in our 4^{th} Day Community. I ask that you each work with me and the Board to go above and beyond to serve in any way that you can with Walks and Gatherings.
